It requires its suppliers to abide by its code of conduct. Partridge Peartree Promotions Limited also conducts factory inspections and audits, which include criteria, related to unacceptable labour practices embodied in the Act.

- Mitigate the risk of slavery and human trafficking occurring in its supply chains.
